

Texoma Valley District Eagle Project Requirements

1. Scout obtains Life to Eagle packet from Texoma Valley Website www.texomavalley.org or Circle Ten Council
2. Scout decides on project idea.
3. Scout discusses his project with his Scoutmaster, or Asst. Scoutmaster for Eagle Scout advancement (someone appointed by the Scoutmaster)
4. Scout discusses project with the proposed beneficiary of the project.
5. Project approved by beneficiary.
 - Beneficiary Representative signs Eagle Workbook.
6. Project approved by Scoutmaster.
 - Scoutmaster signs Eagle workbook.
7. Project approved by Unit Advancement Committee
 - Unit Committee member signs Eagle Workbook
8. Check Eagle Scout Board of review schedule, turn in Workbook **by the deadline** to get project approved by Texoma Valley District Advancement Committee.
9. Project approved by the Committee.
10. Begin your project.
11. Complete project, and all Eagle Scout paperwork and have your Scoutmaster conference **before your 18th Birthday**, preferably within one year of submittal.
12. Obtain a letter from the sponsoring organization that they are happy with your project and that everything was completed to their satisfaction.
13. Completely fill out all pages and forms in the Eagle Scout packet, including the Circle Ten Council Eagle application worksheet.
14. Obtain a copy of advancements from Internet Advancement and submit it with your Eagle Workbook.
15. Check Eagle Scout Board of review schedule, turn in your completed Workbook **by the deadline**.
