CAMP RULES

These rules are for the safety of participants and comply with policies of the Boy Scouts of America:

- * No gasoline or accelerants; propane used only with adult supervision (*locked when not in use*)
- * No open flames in tents
- * No weapons (*firearms, sheath knives, paintball*)
- * No smoking within sight of Scouts
- * No alcoholic beverages
- * No generators
- * No pets
- * No cutting of live trees—use only dead and downed wood if fires are allowed
- * Campfires only allowed in designated areas

WHAT TO BRING

Your Webelos Den Leader may have additional suggestions...

- Tent
- Sleeping bag & pillow
- Cooking, eating, drinking utensils
- Food (*Friday late snack, Saturday breakfast, sack lunch, dinner, Sunday no-cook breakfast*)
- Water bottle or canteen
- Poncho or raincoat
- Jacket
- Clean clothes packed in waterproof bag
- Personal hygiene items (*soap, towel, toothbrush, toothpaste, toilet paper*)
- Flashlight & batteries
- Camp stool or folding chair

CHECK-IN

Webelos and their parent(s) check-in at the Fry Center at the north end of the main parking lot. Since the days are short, you will be setting-up your camp after dark—BE PREPARED!

Each pack will be allowed one vehicle at a time to haul gear to the campsite, so combine your den's gear into a single vehicle in the parking lot.
