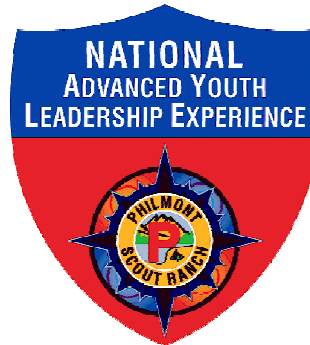


**CIRCLE TEN
